On the income side, adjustments are required to keep the budget deficit for FY2022-23 manageable. The significant growth in interest income is due to increasing interest rates.

On the expense side, there are increased costs across every expense category, in part due to general inflationary pressures. The most significant increase is Employee Expenses. FY23 will be the first full financial year of EFCA having a complete pastoral team on board, with Ps Kenny Kwok and Ps Keven Ng having joined us over the last 12 months. Provision has also been made for the continued calling of a part-time Sunday School Worker/Pastor for the Cantonese Ministry. The increase in Rent and Ministry Activities expenses reflect the anticipated return to uninterrupted, regular in-person worship services and ministry activities without further COVID-related lockdowns.

The Board has decided to increase the weekly offertory target by 10.4% from \$24,000 to \$26,500 for FY23. The Board recognises this is a sizable increase, but it is a necessary measure to ensure the church has adequate resources to look after its congregation and build up God's kingdom.
