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謝友德牧師 Rev. Dr. David Tse

多年前,澳洲一所教會邀請我在他們的退修會講道。 該教會的牧師簡短地訪問我,然後問我最喜歡的聖經 章節是什麼。我的答覆是:

「所以,我親愛的弟兄們,你們務要堅固,不可搖動,常常竭力多做主工,因為知道你們的勞苦,在主裏面不是徒然的。」(林前 15:58)

現在又到了撰寫和閱讀教會年報的時候。我們感謝神帶領我們和我們的事工,亦確信我們在主裏的勞苦必定不是徒然。我們抓住這信念,雖然目標仍未在眼前出現,我們仍向著目標前進。這就像跑馬拉松賽的選手,流著汗與淚繼續堅持,因為他們知道他們必會到達目的地。

我們稱年報為「報告」,其實我們相信我們不單要報告,而在報告之中我們回顧所做和所發生的事,但更重要的目的是向前望,想到在短期和長期的未來裏我們希望會發生的事。

有一本書名為「改變你的問題、改變你的生命」,作者指出提出問題和問正確問題的重要性。我發覺這些問題對我個人生命和事工的規劃都很有幫助。同一思路有另一位作者寫了一個系列的小書,名為「給教會領袖的正確問題」,他說:「領導者不需要答案,他們需要正確的問題。」當然我們都希望有答案,但他的重點是我們經常花時間要尋找答案,其實這些時間若用於找出幾個最影響教會的重要問題,才是善用時間。

一位致力提昇組織健康的專業人才, 曾經協助無數人 成為更好的領導人。他的著作「那最大的益處」提供 六個能幫助我們看清面前路向的問題 -

我們存在是為什麼?

- 我們如何運作?
- 我們在做什麼?
- 我們如何能夠成功?
- 現時最重要的是什麼?
- 那些人必須做那些事?

另一位領導學的作者亦提出「四個每位領袖都應該能 夠答的問題」 —

- 我們要解決的問題是什麼?
- 這個問題是否我們真正要解決的問題?

- 是什麼令我們的解決方案獨特或與眾不同?
- 我有否經常提醒我的團隊我們需要解決的問題是什麼?

對於第一個問題,這位作者引用一位植堂牧者的信念,他說他的使命並非單為成立另一間教會,而是開拓一所懷疑者願意參與的教會。這個未必是你的問題,但這卻正是他要解決的問題。但我們每一個人都要適切地並清楚地答這個問題。

對於第二個問題,他觀察到有一個售賣薄餅的名牌在這個問題上掙扎了很久,最後醒覺到他們其實不單是製作薄餅,他們要解決的問題是為忙碌的家庭和派對活動提供快速並便宜的食品。你要解決的其實是什麼問題?

對於第三個問題,他發現家庭式五金店能夠提供的服務、專才和方便,是大型商場無法比擬的。你的事工的獨特之處是什麼?

對於第四個問題,他建議要檢視我們在這個充斥著衆 多聲音的世界裏如何與別人溝通,不要假設**每個人都** 對問題有共同的看法。尤其重要的是當大家都忙著處 理細節時,便會出現忽略了要看全面性的大圖畫的危 機。你和你的團隊是否能夠拿揑你們的事工和神永恆 計劃的大圖畫?

今年靈福家尋求神對我們未來的帶領之際,我為大家 製造更多問題。過去幾年來我們重新確立了培育「 使人作門徒的門徒」的使命,讓我們一起彼此發掘問 題、共同研讀神的話話、並在祈禱和默想中等候神的 答案。舊約尼希米記是學習領導和管理的絕佳著作, 我相信每一位領導者都能夠從尼希米身上領會神的領 導學智慧。

靈福家現時要處理的不同問題中,其中一個最重要的當然是為教會未來長遠的事工發展尋找更大的地方和空間。故此,這幾方面的操練:問正確的問題、安靜祈禱和在聖靈裏積極的等候,我們都不能忽略。長期以來,我們不明白這些操練就「是」我們的事工,而非為事工而作的事前準備功夫。我們誤以為事奉主就是「做事工」。現在我們必須醒覺,我們踐行這些操練的時候,我們的「勞苦」在主裏面就不會徒然。

Some years ago, I spoke at the retreat of another church in Australia. After the Pastor gave me a brief interview, he asked for my favourite verse of the Bible. Here you go –

"Therefore, my dear brothers and sisters, stand firm. Let nothing move you. Always give yourselves fully to the work of the Lord, because you know that your labour in the Lord is not in vain." (1 Cor 15:58)

This is the time of the year when we write and read annual reports for our ministries. We give thanks to the Lord for guiding us and our ministries. We're affirmed that our labour in Him is never in vain. We continue to hold on to this promise and keep pressing towards the goal even though the destination may not be in sight as yet. This is very much like running in a marathon. The athletes persevere in sweat and tears knowing where the destination is and believing that they will get there.

While we call these annual reports "reports", I guess we know that it's not just reporting that's needed. When we report, we look back at what's been done and what has happened. But the more important purpose is to think ahead towards what we would like to see happen in both the short-term and long-term future.

There's a book entitled "Change Your Questions, Change Your Life". The author points to the importance of asking questions and asking the right questions. I found it immensely helpful as I consider my personal life as well as ministry plans. Along the same line of thinking, another author wrote a series of small books called "Right Questions for Church Leaders" and suggested that "leaders do not need answers; leaders must have the right questions." Well, we do need answers, but what he's trying to highlight is that too often we spend too much time trying to figure out the right answer, while

that time would be more profitably used in discerning a few key questions that may impact the future of the church.

Patrick Lencioni is an organizational health expert whose work has helped thousands to be better leaders. In his book "The Advantage", he offers these six clarifying questions to help us chart the course ahead:

- Why do we exist?
- How do we behave?
- What do we do?
- How will we succeed?
- What is most important right now?
- Who must do what?

Another leadership writer has suggested we consider "4 Questions Every Leader Should be Able to Answer" –

- What is the problem we exist to solve?
- Is the problem we solve really the problem we solve?
- What makes our solution unique or different?
- Am I regularly reminding my team members of the problem we solve?

To the first question, this writer quoted a church planter who believed that his mission was not to just plant another church, but to start a church that skeptical people would attend. This may not be the problem for you, but it was for him. But for all of us, we need to answer this question specifically and with clarity.

To the second question, he observed that one famous brand of pizza shop had struggled through this question and finally worked out that they're not there to sell pizzas, but to solve the problem of providing a quick and affordable meal for busy families and reasonably-priced party food. So what is it for you?

To the third question, he found that local hardware stores provide the kind of service,

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expertise and convenience that big stores cannot match. Where is the uniqueness of your ministry?

To the fourth question, he suggested that we review how we communicate with clarity in a world full of noise and not assume that everyone already has a common understanding of the problem at hand. It is particularly important to address the big picture when everyone is busy with the nitty-gritty and risk losing sight of the larger whole. How well are you and your team members able to grasp the big picture of your ministry and God's eternal plan?

This year, I'm creating more questions than providing answers especially when EFCA contemplates where God is leading us. For the past few years, we have re-affirmed our mission in "making disciples who make disciples." Let's explore together by asking questions of one

another, study God's word with one another and wait upon God's answer in prayer and contemplation. The Book of Nehemiah is an excellent book for leadership and management. I believe every leader should learn God's leadership wisdom through Nehemiah.

One particular issue at hand for EFCA is, among others, of course, the possibility of procuring larger physical spaces for ministry for our longterm development. The disciplines of asking the right questions, praying in silence and active waiting in the Holy Spirit must not be neglected. For too long we did not realise that these disciplines are our ministry and not preparations for the ministry. We thought ministry is just about "doing work". Now we must realise that as we practise these disciplines, our "labour" in the Lord is never in vain.

In English Ministry (EM) we have been glad that there were no more Covid lockdowns or serious restrictions that affected physical ministry since last year's report. Pleasingly, EM has not only returned to pre-Covid church attendance but also increased to now be more than before.

2022

On 25th June, EM member Alice Li married Clinton Jiang of Hebron Alliance Church, & I spoke at their wedding. Since January I had been preparing them both for marriage & they both attend EM as their church.

The 2nd July saw the 5th & final session of our Investigating Christianity Course with 2 of our 3 unbelieving friends attending, with good feedback & openness to meeting again with another course or other topics of interest.

On 13th August, the Recommissioning Service for our EFCA link missionary: Hoi-Yan Shea to return to Japan was held at church, which I led. It was encouraging that 80-90 people attended with representatives from OMF & various link churches, along with family & friends were present.

It was encouraging to attend the EFCA stall at the Chatswood Street Fair on 3rd September, a handful of EM members assisting in a few roles. We were able to use the new EM brochure & had good conversations with the public. Similarly, we were glad to see many EM people at the 35th Anniversary Service on the 25th September. The families had most of the children involved in the Kids Song, & many young adults stayed after the service to have lunch together at the Concourse. Approximately 20 EM members attended the 35th Anniversary Dinner on 15th October.

From mid October onwards, as the EM Sunday adult service attendance began to be 100+, along with 15-20 children in Kids' Church, we noticed that this was back to the pre-Covid numbers of 120-130 in 2020 before the first lockdown. The attendance & fellowship were further enhanced & encouraged by official church lunch

On 26th November, I married EM couple
Matthew Chow & Stephanie Wong at St
Barnabas Anglican Broadway, their wedding
& reception were attended by a large number
of EM young adults. Both continue to attend &
serve in EM.

On 4th December was our EM baptism service, with Coran Ho & Joshua Lai being baptised, along with Samuel Lim having his membership transferred.

On 11th December was the official farewell for our outgoing student pastor: Paolo Santillan. Paolo had indicated after 1st semester of his Moore Theological College study that he would not continue these studies beyond 2022. He believed he was not suited to be in a full time pastoral role in church ministry, but would serve in part time ministry roles in Sydney's western suburbs. Currently, he is serving in part time chaplaincy ministry with Lalor Park Anglican Church, & working casually in high school teaching.

As Christmas Eve was on Saturday, we decided to have a family friendly Christmas Eve Service

at 7pm & we had 59 adults. The Christmas Day Service had 106 adults with a number of visitors.

2023

On 14th January I married EM couple Justin Lam & Dawn Ee at Dockside Darling Harbour, with a large number of EM young adults attending. Dawn was previously attending ESCCC in Randwick, but upon their marriage is now attending EM with Justin.

Cantonese ESL resumed on 6th February at Chatswood Church of Christ from 10am-12:15pm on Mondays, & I began to teach the intermediate class with the help of Norma Chan & Vanessa Lai (EM young adult). We began using materials provided by previous teacher: Erica Garvey. Erica had indicated in January that she would not be teaching at our ESL for 2023, as her home church had requested her help with their ESL also on Monday mornings.

From February onwards, we noted that the EM Sunday service adult attendance has been usually above 110 & along with 15-25 children at Kids' Church, this meant an increase of EM attendance pre-Covid which was 120-130 in 2020. Many 2023 weeks saw our attendance from 130-150. English Ministry Team (EMT) began to discuss creating more space for our 11am Service, of service overflow into the side hall, rather than the foyer. The side hall will also have more room for a creche area (which can be marked out by play pen fencing & soft mats for children aged 0-4) & secluded space for breastfeeding Mums. Currently, the AV team is purchasing & trialling long cabling from the chapel to side hall to facilitate the future overflow into the side hall.

EM Growth Groups (bible studies) were launched on 26th February & many were reshuffled as they were the same the previous

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2 years. Most GG-s use the matching bible study series that follow the Sunday sermon series.

At Lindfield East Public School (LEPS), Special Religious Education (SRE – Scripture) class began on 28th February, & I teach a Year 6 SRE class for this year. My Lindfield Learning Village (LLV) SRE Yr 3-6 class began on 1st March.

On 18th March, EMT gathered from 10am – 3pm for our Strategy Day, some key discussion was a review of our EM ministries in light of disciple-making frameworks from last year & these are progressing in the right direction without drastic changes needed. Also, if EM would consider starting a second service: e.g. an evening service before or after EFCA moves to 518 Pacific Hwy property. At this stage EMT concluded it would be better to move to 518 first, then consider starting a second service, due to the uncertainties for planning.

Our Good Friday & Easter Day services were well attended with 127 & 141 adults

respectively. It was encouraging that keen Cantonese service brethren visited & brought family, friends along with other new visitors. Good Friday saw a children's Easter Egg hunt after the service, Easter Day had a pre-service hot cross bun morning tea.

On Sunday 28th May, the 3 new approved members: David Phan, Trevor Ko & Yeddi Yip (married to Trevor Ko) gave their testimonies & received their membership certificates during the 11am service.

Conclusion: EM is looking forward to increasing our seating capacity with the side hall overflow. Our weekend retreat on 25th-27th August, the topic being: 'The Gospel We Share', following on from that we aim to have Investigating Christianity course where unbelieving family & friends can be invited. May the Lord increase us spiritually & numerically for his glory!

近几个月来,我们国语同工集体灵修《彼得前书》,通过逐章逐节的学习,让我再次思考如何应对困难和挑战。蒙恩信主后,并非一帆风顺,我们会面临各种挑战和苦难,经历试炼。《彼得前书》提醒我们要有心理准备,明白苦难的意义,并教导我们效法基督,存心顺服,为义受苦,展现圣洁生活。

《彼得前书》是使徒彼得写给众教会的,大约在主后65年左右。初期教会兴旺发展,同时也面临苦难逼迫。众信徒生活贫困,经常受到恐吓、诬告和迫害,面对如此困境,他们不免忧愁产生怀疑:作为基督徒,为什么会遭受如此多的苦难?甚至有些人的信仰产生了动摇。彼得写信的目的就是要阐明真理:你们暂时忧愁,是叫你们的信心经过试验,比那被火试验仍然能坏的金子更显宝

贵。这样, 你们在耶稣基督显现的时候, 就能得着称赞、 荣耀、尊贵。(1章6-7节)

• 基督徒必定会经历试炼:

信主后,基督徒的生活并非一帆风顺,天空并不总是晴朗,花香也不会常漫,我们需要有心理准备,作为主的门徒,我们必定会经历试炼,生活中会遇到挑战、困难,甚至逼迫。那些宣扬追求健康和财富的福音,误导了信徒,他们声称如果我们对神有真正的信心,就能在今生获得丰盛的物质和财富,他们认为神会按照人们的信心赐予健康、财富和权力。他们讲述一个虚假的福音,告诉信徒他们今生会过上奢华的生活,住豪宅、穿名牌服饰、享受美食,同时,他们宣称神也会除去信徒身上的疾病。这种所谓的成功神学是典型的人本主义神学,将人放在

中心,源自人贪爱世界的本性。成功神学没有教导信徒付出代价的门徒生活,导致信徒在读经、祷告、事奉等方面缺乏真正的奉献精神,他们认为读经可有可无,祷告只是为了自己的利益,甚至连事奉也随心所欲。

《彼得前书》教导我们,信徒不仅要面对试炼,而且要面对各种各样的试炼,来自四面八方接踵而至,让我们感到四面受敌,几乎无法承受。在生活中我们会遇到许多困难和问题,面对疾病和贫困,不要感到奇怪,因为这是神为我们预备的培训计划。

• 信心经讨试炼更显宝贵:

我们已经立志委身给神,为什么还要经历试炼呢?彼得告诉我们试炼的目的是检验我们的信心是否真实坚定。试炼就像火一样严峻,绝非儿戏,彼得用火来形容考验的严峻程度,用金子来形容真正的信心,非常贴切。火是一个很好的媒介用来检验金子的真伪。将金子放入火中烧,假的会显露原形,而真的则越炼越精。只有在高温下,才能将金子与杂质分离,同样,只有在试炼临到时,我们的真实面目才会显露出来。试炼的目的是考验我们的信心。

我们的信心经过试验,比金子更显宝贵,试炼能够显明信心的真实内涵。在风平浪静的日子里,没有苦难、没有试炼,每个人都会觉得自己非常属灵,非常爱神。但一旦

风吹草动,情况就会改变,例如,平时学习不紧张、工作轻松时大家愿意参加聚会,但考试临近、工作繁忙时,很多人就不见了。如果我们只在平静无事的日子里跟随神请不要自夸,因为那并不能证明什么,真正的考验是在困难重重的情况下,我们仍然能够祈求神继续跟随祂,因为只有这样,信心才是真实的信心。

• 将来得称赞、荣耀和尊贵:

只有那些经过试炼的信心, 那些合格的基督徒才能在天国里有份, 一个合格的基督徒能够经受时间和环境的考验, 也能够被神塑造成合祂心意的人。在这里鼓励大家, 当我们面对试炼时, 不要埋怨, 不要心怀不平, 相反, 我们应当向神祷告: "主啊, 我知道这试炼对我们来说非常艰难, 求神赐给我智慧和能力, 使我能够站立得稳, 信心更加坚定, 好成为合神心意的子民。"

圣经教导我们:我们所遇到的试探,无论多么艰难,都不会超过我们所能承受的范围,在试探中神必给我们开辟一条出路。神是信实的,祂不会让我们受到超过我们能承受的试探,神与我们同在,祂选择我们、眷顾我们、保护我们。神允许我们面临各种人生境遇的目的是要塑造我们,愿神赐福给我们,在百般试炼中,我们的信心得到验证,最终在天国里得荣耀。荣耀归于神!

最近我們教會面對最重要的挑戰,就是購買堂址。而 我相信其中最重要的是信心。

所以與大家分享一下雅各書論到信心的重點,彼此提醒:

「5 你們中間若有缺少智慧的,該求那厚賜與眾人又不 斥責人的上帝,上帝必賜給他。6 只要憑著信心求,一 點也不疑惑;因為那疑惑的人,就像海中的波浪被風吹 動翻騰。7 這樣的人不要想從主那裏得到甚麼。8 三 心二意的人,在他一切所行的路上都搖擺不定。」(雅各 書1:5-8, 和修版)

第一點:信心求甚麼?要用信心求智慧。

已故的屬靈偉人華倫韋斯比曾說:「當我們即將經歷神所命定的困難時,應當禱告些甚麼呢?雅各給了我

們答案:向神祈求智慧。....當我們經歷試煉的時候, 為甚麼需要智慧呢?為甚麼不祈求力量、恩典,或者 脫離試煉?原因是:我們需要智慧,這樣才不會浪費 神給我們的每個成長機會。智慧幫助我們明白,如何 為著自己的益處和神的榮耀來使用這些境遇。」

若果這應用在我們購買堂址這件事上,我們發現在這件事上無論在買賣物業或會眾溝通的方面,情況實在是千變萬化,在甚麼準確的時間,說甚麼準確的說話,也是需要十分斟酌的,有時候也給予我們教會發展委員會的成員、同工及執事們,似乎都產生很大的壓力。但正是這樣,我們就必須按着主的應許,以信心為他們求額外的智慧, 以致我們能面對這個非一般的挑戰,成為我們屬靈成長的歷程 - 一個被主帶領屬靈的經歷。

第二點:我們需具備一種怎樣的信心?一種堅定不移的信心。

這裡有不同的表達方法,說出那種不堅定的信心是如何的:

「因為那疑惑的人,就像海中的波浪被風吹動翻騰」-是高高低低; 「 三心二意的人」- 前一分鐘說是,後 一分鐘說不; 「在他一切所行的路上都搖擺不定」- 像 喝醉酒的人,腳步左搖右擺不穩定。

請留意那個警告那些人會有這樣的結果:「這樣的人不要想從主那裡得到甚麼」;但相反,一個不疑惑的

信心的結果應是這樣的: 他絕不三心兩意, 他會從主 那裡得到一切!

我們不是盲目相信的那種「堅定不移」,而是一種有根據的堅信,因為我們信仰的對象,是那位深愛我們的全能主宰!所以無論是何種結果,我們完全相信神的安排,而祂是必定給我們最好的!我們作為領袖及真基督徒,必須先檢視我們有這樣的一種信心,才能一起走上這信心的一步。

讓我們在這個關鍵的時機,專心為我們領袖及我們教會所有會眾,都有智慧及有堅定的信心來禱告。

Leading by the Lord - Our Faith in the Spiritual Journey of Construction of the Church

Recently, our church has faced the most important challenge, which is to purchase a new site for our congregation. And I believe that the most important aspect of this challenge is "faith". So today, I would like to share with you the key points about "faith" from James 1:5-8 to remind each other.

Please read the NET Bible translation below:

1:5 But if anyone is deficient in wisdom, he should ask God, who gives to all generously and without reprimand, and it will be given to him.

1:6 But he must ask in faith without doubting, for the one who doubts is like a wave of the sea, blown and tossed around by the wind. 1:7 For that person must not suppose that he will receive anything from the Lord, 1:8 since he is a double-minded individual, unstable in all his ways.

What should we ask for with faith? We should ask for "wisdom".

Warren Wiersbe explains this passage: "When we are about to face the difficulties that God has ordained for us, what should we pray for? James gives us the answer: ask God for wisdom...Why do we need wisdom when we face trials? Why

not pray for strength, grace, or deliverance? The reason is that we need wisdom so that we will not waste any of the growth opportunities that God gives us. Wisdom helps us understand how to use these situations for our own benefit and for God's glory."

If this is applied to our purchase of a church property in this moment, we find that the situation is very complicated - whether we are talking about the buying and selling of properties or communication with the congregation, circumstances keep changing. It all requires careful consideration of when to speak and what to say at the right time. Sometimes, this seems to put a lot of pressure on members of the church development committee. Therefore, we must rely on the promise of the Lord and have faith in seeking additional wisdom for them so that we can face this extraordinary challenge - This is a spiritual growth experience for all of us.

What kind of faith do we need? We need an unwavering trust in Lord.

There are different expressions to describe how weak faith is: 1)"the one who doubts is like a wave of the sea,": ups and downs all the time; 2) a "double-minded" individual: saying yes one minute and no the next; 3) unstable in all his

ways: like a drunk person, stumbling around unsteadily.

Please note the warning that those who have this kind of faith will have such consequences: "For that person MUST NOT SUPPOSE that he will RECEIVE ANYTHING from the Lord."

On the contrary, the result of an unwavering faith is like this: "he must ask in faith without doubting." We can say it vice versa: "For that person MUST SUPPOSE that he will RECEIVE EVERYTHING from the Lord."

We believe in this, don't we?

Our unwavering trust is not "a blind faith"; because it is based on the reliability of the object of our faith, which is our AlMIGHTY LORD. Therefore, regardless of the outcome of our deal, our faith is to fully believe in God's arrangement, and He will definitely give us the best at last! As leaders and the genuine christian, we need to examine ourselves to see if we have this kind of faith, so that we can walk along with all brothers and sisters with spiritual influence and walk in this faith.

Let us focus our prayers at this critical moment for our leaders and all members of our church to have wisdom and unwavering trust in our Lord.

Let's pray together in faith.

隨着我們已踏入2023年的年中,疫情引起的變化, 大家對新常態的現況,亦已慢慢接納了,近年通貨膨 脹,物價高企,政治的不穩定性,俄烏戰爭等問題, 戰 爭亦好似會隨時會爆發,常常聽到周遭身邊的人, 對 環境的事物,都怨聲載道,經濟還有沒有很大的復 興,人心惶惶,人心裏總是忐忑不安,也聽到不少基 督徒常常也發出這些的聲音。偶爾看到「老牧人」的 這篇文章,讓我若有所思,也願藉着他的文章,作為 彼此的分享和提醒,教導我們如何憑着信心倚靠神。

「耶和華豈有難成的事」創世記19:1

這段聖經是描述神的使者,向亞伯拉罕顯現。告訴他明年他的妻子撒拉會懷孕生子,撤拉背後「暗笑」,因為當時亞伯拉罕已九十九歲,年紀老邁,她自己的月經也已斷絕了,豈可能會有這種美事呢?所以她在這方面的信心不夠,耶和華的使者責問她為何「暗笑」,因而說出「耶和華豈有難成的事」。

事實上當上帝的使者向亞伯拉罕夫婦要懷孕生子的應 許時,從人的角度來看,這是一件不可能實現的夢 想,然而,正如聖經所說:「在人所不能,在神凡是 都能。」我們所敬奉的神是一位能使不能變為可能的 神,是使人在絕望中獲得盼望的神,而就是這位神曾 應允我們, 祂是我們的好牧人, 祂有能力帶領我們勝過一切的困擾、挫折、使我們經驗到「耶和華豈有難成的事」, 因此我們應當憑着信心, 將每一件事帶來與祂商量、求幫助、求引導。

在哪裡?

以利在以色列人與非利士人戰爭中失去了兩個兒子。除此之外,神的約櫃也在戰爭中被擴去(撒上4:11)。對以色列人來說,這是非常挫敗的事情,因為神的約櫃竟然落在外邦人手中。耶和華豈不是以色列人的神嗎?祂不是住在以色列人當中嗎?祂不是為以色列人爭戰的神嗎?以利因神的約櫃被擴去,驚嚇仆倒跌而死(撒上4:18)。同時,以利的兒婦正在準備生產。按照常理,每一位臨盆的婦人的關注點都在於即將出生的嬰孩身上一然而一她沒有。她只給孩子起名叫「以迦博」(撒上4:21),希伯來文的「以」是「在哪裡?」、「沒有」的意思。希伯來文的「迦博」是「榮耀」意思。所以,以利的兒婦生產之時,她關心的是「神的榮耀在哪裡?」或「神的榮耀離開了以色列!」先知以利和他的兩個兒子得罪了耶和華,導致耶和華和祂的榮耀要離開以利家。

蒙福的屬靈生命就是要渴想神 一 時常渴想神的同在,渴望神的榮耀充滿在生命之中,用生命去見證衪的榮耀。所以,神的兒女要時常警惕自己的生命,省察自己有沒有時常與神連結,好讓神的榮耀常在生命之中。 過往一年,每一位弟兄姊妹盡心、盡力、盡忠去事奉神、服侍教會。為了事奉神,弟兄姊妹樂意擺上,用心做好 每一項事奉。然而,我們當如何事奉,才能讓神的榮耀顯在其中呢?我認為:事奉者的內在生命素質非常重要,若果事奉者沒有好好培養自己的靈性 (尤其是自己的情緒),即使付出了時間和心力去服侍,事奉的果效卻是枉然。普遍華人教會的事奉觀只講求果效,卻鮮有著重事奉者屬靈生命健康,包括身體、心理、情緒及原生家庭帶來的影響。若然事奉者能夠探索自己的生命。要多,並加上屬靈生命的操練,必然會結出更多果子,榮神益人。盼望靈福堂的弟兄姊妹不但一起在屬靈生命上努力操練,也更開放去接觸自己的內在生命,使靈福家成為榮神益人的群體。

在這個充滿挑戰和機遇的時代,我們作為牧者和領袖, 負有極重要的責任一引導信徒們在基督裡建立堅固的 靈命。我們都渴望自己和我們的教會能夠成為基督的門 徒,熱切地追求靈修、祈禱、讀經、事奉和傳福音等等。 這些都是非常重要的事情,我們應該努力去實踐。

然而,有時候我們不禁會問自己,這些事情真的能夠使 我們更親近神嗎?有時候,我們可能在事奉中感到忙碌 而乾枯,或者讀完聖經後仍感到虛空,在面對當下的困 難時找不到答案。在這樣的時刻,我們該如何應對呢?

我想分享一個循道會的創辦人—約翰衛斯理的觀點。他 提出了建立基督徒生命的四條支柱,就像建造一座堅固 的房屋一樣,缺一不可。

第一個支柱是聖經。我們經常讀聖經,因為我們明白聖經是上帝對我們的啟示,祂透過其中向我們展示祂的心意一祂如何愛我們、我們的罪性是怎樣的、祂的拯救應許以及教會在基督再來前應該扮演的角色等等。透過閱讀聖經,我們不僅認識到我們所信仰的上帝是怎樣的,也更清楚明白祂的拯救計劃。

第二個支柱是傳統。除了聖經,傳統也非常重要。基督信仰並非一蹴而就的產物,而是經過2000多年的傳承才形成的。在這個傳承的過程中,發生了許多重要的事件,建立出我們現在所相信的「基督教」。例如,你知道為什麼我們稱自己為「Free」的原因是什麼呢?

傳統告訴我們教會的教義,並教導我們如何實踐這些教義。每個時代的神學家都面對著當時的重要議題,他們的思考和解釋對我們來說是寶貴的資源。歷史往往會重複,我們今天所面臨的問題很可能在過去已經有人思考

過並給出解答。因此, 傳統可以成為我們今天的參考和 指南。

第三個支柱是理性。當我們面對聖經和傳統時,常常會 遇到不同的解釋和見解。這使得我們需要作出選擇。在 這樣的情況下,理性是不可或缺的因素。我們需要理性 地思考,為什麼一個觀點比另一個更可取,這將有助於 我們的信仰更加清晰、連貫,也能更好地分享給他人: 我們相信什麼。

最後一個支柱是經驗。我相信每個人都有自己的信仰經驗,可能是在禱告中經歷到上帝的安慰,或者看到神應允我們的禱告。也許是在困難中看到上帝與我們同在,或者在事奉中感受到上帝的加力與同工。有時候,上帝可能呼召我們到特定的崗位服事,讓我們看到特定群體的需要。

透過經驗,我們可以更深入地認識上帝。這是一種實實在在的經歷,因為我們是親身經歷者。然而,我們需要透過聖經、傳統來評估這些經驗,確認是否是上帝的工作。同時,在群體中進行理性思考,以確定這是上帝的工作。

親愛的弟兄姊妹們,我鼓勵你們思考並建立信仰生活的四個支柱:聖經、傳統、理性和經驗。這些支柱將使你們的靈命更加堅固、持久,也能夠成為信徒們的榜樣。作為牧者和領袖,我們要帶領他人建立這些支柱,讓他們在困難和挑戰中得到堅定和指引。

讓我們彼此扶持,一同在基督裡成長,並用我們的生命 見證上帝的愛和恩典。願這些支柱成為我們靈命建造的 指南,使我們成為神所喜悅的僕人和牧者。

In this challenging and opportunistic era, as pastors and leaders, we bear a significant responsibility: to guide believers in building a strong spiritual life in Christ. We all yearn to become disciples of Christ, eagerly pursuing spiritual disciplines such as spiritual retreats, prayer, Bible reading, serving, and spreading

the Gospel. These are all vital aspects that we should strive to practice.

However, there are times when we can't help but question whether these pursuits truly bring us closer to God. Sometimes, we may feel overwhelmed and spiritually dry in our service, or we may finish reading the Bible and still feel

empty, unable to find answers to the challenges we face. In such moments, how should we respond?

I would like to share the perspective of John Wesley, the founder of the Methodist movement. He proposed four pillars for building the Christian life, much like constructing a sturdy house, with each pillar being indispensable.

The first pillar is the Bible. We read the Bible frequently because we understand it as God's revelation, through which He shows us His heart, His love for us, the nature of sin, His promise of salvation, and the role of the Church while awaiting the return of Christ. By reading the Bible, we not only come to know the nature of the God we believe in but also gain a clearer understanding of His plan of redemption.

The second pillar is tradition. In addition to the Bible, tradition holds great importance. The Christian faith did not emerge overnight but has been passed down through over two thousand years of history. Throughout this tradition, many significant events have shaped what we now believe as "Christianity." For example, do you know the meaning of our denomination's English name? Why do we refer to ourselves as the "Free Church," and what does it mean to be "free"?

Tradition informs us of the Church's doctrines and guides us in practicing these teachings. The theologians of each era faced pressing issues that demanded a response. Just like when Hitler rose to power, the Church had to decide whether to pledge allegiance. The German theologian Dietrich Bonhoeffer proposed the cost of discipleship and the concept of costly grace.

Humanity tends to repeat the same mistakes, and history often repeats itself. Therefore, the issues we face today may not be entirely "new" but have been contemplated and explained by our predecessors. They serve as valuable references for us today.

The third pillar is reason. When faced with the Bible and tradition, we often encounter various interpretations and perspectives. This requires us to make choices. Relying solely on "feelings" or personal preferences is insufficient. Reason plays an essential role in determining why one viewpoint is more preferable than another. It helps make our faith clearer, more coherent, and more effectively shareable with others: What do we believe in?

The final pillar is experience. I believe that each one of us has experienced moments of faith. It may be experiencing God's comfort during prayer, witnessing answered prayers, seeing God's presence in times of difficulty, or feeling empowered and united with God in service. Sometimes, God may call us to specific positions of service, allowing us to witness the needs of certain communities.

Through experience, we can gain a deeper understanding of God. It is a tangible and personal encounter because we are firsthand witnesses. However, to discern whether these experiences are the work of God, we need to evaluate them through the lenses of the Bible and tradition. Additionally, engaging in rational thinking within the community helps confirm that it is indeed the work of God.

Dear brothers and sisters, I encourage you to reflect on how you can establish the pillars of your faith in the coming year, encompassing the Bible, tradition, reason, and experience. These pillars will strengthen your spiritual life.

Overview

Since last year report the Lord provided CDC an opportunity to have further communication with the owner of 518 Pacific Highway Lane Cove North. CDC was authorised by Deacons Board to proceed with the subdivision application to 3 lots of East Lindfield Church property, and it was lodged on 23 March 2023.

Communication with the owner of 518 Pacific Highway Land Cove North

Since September/October 2022, the Lord provided an opportunity to communicate with the developer of 518 Pacifica Highway Lane Cove North regarding potential to purchase 50% of the property. Further to continuous discussion and face to face coffee meeting, the following events happened as follows:

 The Deacons Board decided first to proceed with the subdivision application of East Lindfield church property into 3 lots as per the decision endorsed in 2016 AGM. The application was lodged in March 2023 and is with Council for assessment. The purpose is to appreciate the land value of East Lindfield property.

- Since the developer indicated their interest in purchasing our East Lindfield property, besides proceeding with the subdivision application, both parties agreed to obtain professional valuation reports of both 518 Pacific Highway Lane Cove North and 28 30 Wellington Road East Lindfield. Looking at almost 100 children under EFCA children ministry across 3 x languages, especially high growth rate of young families migrated from Hong Kong, please continue to pray for the provision of a part time children ministry pastor/worker (for Cantonese children ministry) and a larger venue for future development under His Guidance and Grace.

The purpose of the Finance Committee is to provide prayerful and considered advice and support to the Deacons Board on financial matters. It is part of the governance of a healthy and financially responsible church. The Committee reviewed and advised on budgeting, cost savings, accounting and stipend matters during the year. Financial Position

The Australian economy is recovering from the COVID-19 pandemic, while facing additional pressures locally from the very high inflation and externally from slow-downs in overseas economies. Although the Reserve Bank of Australia lifted the interest rate 12 times since May 2022, the cost of living have continued to increase significantly over the period. We have also observed similar increases in all expense categories in our church's day-to-day operations. By God's grace and provision, the General Fund have shown a modest surplus for Financial Year (FY) 2022-23, despite the budget originally projecting a deficit of almost \$98,000. While offertory income tracked below target by

circa 9.1%, this was more than offset by actual expenses being lower than budget, particularly in relation to rent and ministry activities. The lower expenses was largely due to the COVID-19 restrictions in physical worship services and ministry activities earlier in the year. Praise the Lord for His provision that EFCA's overall financial position continued to be sound.

Church Finance in Coming Years

Very high inflationary and volatile economy in this post pandemic environment has made our church's budget and forecast for the new year challenging. In FY2023-24, the high inflation and high living expenses is expected to continue, and increase the overall budget pressures on our church.

A fully break-even budget outcome for FY2023-24 would require a 10% increase to the weekly offertory target. The Committee recognised this level of increase would place a very heavy burden on the congregation. Therefore a smaller 5% increase was recommended, which was adopted by the Deacons Board. As a result, the FY2023-24 budget is projected to be a deficit of around \$44,600, which if actual experience matches with budget, the deficit will need to be drawn from the General Fund Reserve. Looking further ahead, if inflation continues at current levels into the near future, the offertory target will need to increase by 5.9% in FY2024-25 to achieve a break-even budget outcome. In order to meet the offertory target, we will likely require an increase in the average offertory amount per person and a growth in the number of persons able and willing to commit consistently in offertory.

There are a few known challenges in achieving these targets in the coming years. It is acknowledged that the present economic environment may limit our ability to significantly lift our personal offertory amounts. At the same

time, the cost of renting our physical meeting places has been increasing, and are often already close to full capacity which limits further growth. There is also always an uncertainty that the current leases may discontinue, which means we need to hire alternative venues and often at a much higher rent cost. These challenges and uncertainties may result in higher deficits than expected, and therefore we need to draw down the General Fund Reserve more frequently in the coming years. Our goal is to maintain a target balance of over \$770,000 in the General Fund Reserve. This equates to about six months' cover of our church's operating expenses, and is considered reasonable for a growing church. Should the FY2023-24 budget deficit be realised or exceeded, the General Fund Reserve is likely to drop below the target balance. We pray for God's continued provision and to strengthen our faith.

Other Church Reserve Funds

The General Fund relates to the church's dayto-day operating income and expenses. There
are also other reserve funds such as the Mission
Fund that need our ongoing faithful support in
offertory. Please refer to the Financial Accounts
for details. They are just as important in serving
their respective purposes in fulfilling the
mission of the church.

- 我們已進行多次的外展佈道活動,包括區內派單張 做問卷、逐戶派傳單及元宵節燈謎、寫揮春及攤位遊 戲等;

- 我們從6月到9月,組織了四場針對家長的講座,其中兩場通過網上Zoom進行,另外兩場實體在喜悅軒舉行,每場超過40人報名,回應正面;

每月第二個週四早上十時半至下午十二時半,男士天空弟兄們於網上相聚。除研經分享外,亦有楊牧師或麥牧師透過「善牧恩言」及個別弟兄負責的「靈修見証分享」兩個環節。感謝主!每次弟兄們不單有聖經研讀、見証分享及彼此代禱的時間,更有神學及實體聚會,後決定於今年五月二日星期二試舉行一次實體聚會。此次反應理想,亦有助加深弟兄主內的情誼。考慮到不少弟兄的實際情況,核心小組決定日後將採用混合模式,即每月的月會繼續於網上進行,而實體聚會則每三至四個月舉行一次。

靈修查經方面,我們繼續查考「十二使徒塑造」的主題。論到保羅「活在基督裏」的神學觀,「在基督耶穌裏」這用詞,是保羅書信中一個最重要又最難掌握的概念。究竟「活在基督裏」有甚麼意義呢?

1. 基督徒身份的改變:

楊劍標弟兄 Matthew Yeung

在我們還未認識主耶穌基督之前的舊身份,我們是看 重世界的價值觀,以我們的外在形象和表現來討人喜 悅,希望別人認為我們是可愛的,是可以接納的,是 成功的。這或許只能維持一段時間,最終我們會再次 感覺失望,被拒絕,不可愛,是毫無價值的。若要從 外在的滿足來解決我們身份問題,是毫無功效的,因 為心中沒有神,內心的空虛是不能用外在的因素充 滿,這是因為我們的靈被肉體和魂轄制,是完全跟神 的靈和神的生命隔絕。

當我們接受主耶穌基督時,我們便是新造的人,有新的身份。聖靈更新了我們的靈,藉著耶穌寶血的潔淨,神的靈居住在我們裏面。這身份的改變,正如保羅向哥林多教會宣講的:「若有人在基督裏,他就是新造的人,舊事已過,都變成新的了」(林後5:17)。在基督裏面,我們跟神的性情有份。

「活在基督裏」就是活在一個父與兒女的親密關係中,神要我們跟祂的關係是父與兒女的關係,不是因為懼怕。使徒約翰說:「**愛裏沒有懼怕;愛既完全**,

就把懼怕除去,因為懼怕裏含著刑罰;懼怕的人在愛 裏未得完全」(約一4:18),神就是愛。

「活在基督裏」就是活在主的愛與憐憫中。 在彼得三次不認主的例子中,耶穌已經預知彼得將會失敗,但 他並未阻止彼得去經歷失敗,為的是使他可以謙卑回 到神面前。這是需要一個內在的改變和悔改,因為主 耶穌要我們跟祂的關係是建立在祂的愛和憐憫上。

2. 蒙揀選、得恩惠:

在彼得前書使徒彼得勸勉信徒要過正直而聖潔的生活,他說:「惟有你們是被揀選的族類,是有君尊的祭司,是聖潔的國度,是屬神的子民,要叫你們宣揚那召你們出黑暗、入奇妙光明者的美德。你們從前算不得子民,現在卻作了神的子民;從前未曾蒙憐恤,現在卻蒙了憐恤」(彼前2: 9-10)。

世界的標準是以你的表現和外在的形象來判斷你是誰。法利賽人看西門是一個沒有知識的漁夫,耶穌卻看他為建立教會的彼得。我們以屬世的智慧來看待事情,這便迎合了撒旦的詭計,會被屬世的智慧蒙騙,撒旦會千方百計使我們離開在基督裏得勝的地位。在基督裏我們已經有了新的身份,這身份決定我們所應該做的一切。因此,我們就萬不可繼續做一些不合乎「在基督裏」身份的事,因為我們已經「蒙揀選、得恩惠」。

3. 往下紮根、向上結果:

我們必須紮根在基督裏,持續地活在祂裏面,不要離開「在基督裏」的身份,因為這樣才能讓十字架的生命從生活中流露出來。當我們站穩「在基督裏」的地位時,我們便可以勝過罪的試探,因為我們向罪看自己是死的。一切的試探都是引誘我們去靠自己來滿足自己的需要。

撒旦也企圖使耶穌用自己的方法去滿足自己人性的需要,包括:

- 身體的需要: 把石頭變麵包滿足飢餓;

- 魂的需要: 證明自己是神的兒子;

- 靈的需要: 為了得著世界的榮耀而敬拜撒旦。

但是耶穌在面對試探時, 祂選擇完全依靠神。祂知道 自己的身份是誰, 不需要再去證明, 所以祂沒有犯 罪。

我們若持續地跟隨主的腳蹤行,我們必然結出屬靈的 果子。主對門徒說:「**我是葡萄樹,你們是枝子,常** 在我裏面的,我也常在他裏面,這人就多結果子,因 為離了我,你們就不能做甚麼」(約15:5)。

4. 信靠神,屬靈生命得以成長:

「活在基督裏」,藉著上帝的真理加強我們的信心。 當我們陷在考驗中的時候,神的話語會臨到我們, 帶給我們內心的平安與盼望,我們的信心也因此得剛 強。彼得雖然三次不認耶穌而經歷慘痛的失敗,但耶 穌藉著祂重新肯定的話語重建了彼得,彼得的信心使 他相信神在他最大的失敗上饒恕了他。

「活在基督裏」我們每時每刻都經歷主的同在,我們需要每一個時刻都定睛在耶穌身上。在我們生命中每一個困難環境,都是一個讓我們更能信靠神的學習機會,使我們的屬靈生命得以成長。

5. 活出「常常喜樂、不住禱告、凡事謝恩」的生命: 保羅在腓立比教會勸勉信徒說:「你們要靠主常常喜樂!我再說,你們要喜樂」(腓4:4)。「你們要靠主 常常喜樂」的原文是「你們要在主裏常常喜樂」,而 「在主裏」是指信徒與主聯結的情況,他們屬靈就是「 玩是建立在主裏的,保羅勸勉信徒喜樂的關鍵就是「 靠主」。他們喜樂的根源是「主」,信徒之所仍然 喜樂是因為他是與主聯結,以致他在憂愁中仍然 喜樂是因為他是與主聯結,以致他在憂愁中仍然 喜樂。由此看來,信徒的喜樂不在於環境上的改變,而 是活在永不改變的主裏。所以,一個基督徒永遠不會 失掉他的喜樂,因為他永遠不會失去基督。這是一件 值得喜樂的事實。

在保羅所寫的書信中,他必會督促信徒注意禱告的義務和權利,提醒他們在禱告中要恆切:「你們要恆切禱告,在此警醒感恩」(西4:2)。恆切的禱告就是要堅持或緊握不放,堅持就是要持續作同一件事,好像耶穌向門徒設的一個比喻,那充滿精力的小寡婦,絲毫不給當地那不義的官安靜休息的機會(路18:1-8)。

「活在基督裏」的禱告,不應該出於焦慮,而是要出 於感恩,缺乏感恩的禱告,神不會聽。信徒要存著「 不住禱告」的態度過一個與神相交的生活,以致禱告 自然地成為生活的一個重要環節。

「常存感恩的心」(西3:15) 是基督徒在基督裏行事為人的特徵之一,而感恩是要以行動來表達感激之情,因為神在基督裏拯救了我們 (西1:14)。能夠不斷地感恩,是因為我們被「基督的靈」充滿,是聖靈在我們裏面工作的明證,讓我們不斷述說上帝的美

善。神賜救恩不是因為我們有任何功勞,也不可能靠 著自己的美德去得到這些恩典,唯有上帝開恩賜給我 們。

所以,我們無論在甚麼時候,總會找到一些值得謝恩的事情,甚至生活在最困難的黑暗日子中,我們總會在自己身上找到一些主的恩典。當每位基督徒為自己所領受的恩典獻上感謝時,眼目就已定睛於基督身上。亦自然會想到,自己所擁有的都是出自上帝的恩賜。所以,基督徒必須時刻讚美上帝,常存感恩的心,因為祂是一切賜福的源泉。

We also wish to thank the new and existing AV members for continuing to juggle audio and visual for both livestream and in-person attendance simultaneously.

For the latter half of 2023, we will dig into Exodus and 1 & 2 Peter. Pray for wisdom and faithful teaching as Pastor Hoong, other guest speakers and the leaders prepare each week. Pray also that God will sustain the leaders as they balance serving at SWITCH and life,

ministry and other personal commitments.

Thank God for all the socials, evangelistic events, and meet-ups between youth and leaders. SWITCH is also looking forward to attending the KYCK Conference in September 2023. Pray that many will be able to join, and that this will be a fruitful time that challenges the youth in their faith, and grow them in community with other youth across Sydney.

Pray that God will continue to use these opportunities to build up the youth in line with our SWITCH vision, to 'proclaim Jesus as Lord and equip youth to be passionate lifelong disciples of Jesus to serve His community and His world.'

Growth Groups | Jia Au-yeung

We thank God for His provision to Growth Groups ministry with new and continuing Growth Group leaders for our expanding ministry.

We began the year with a Growth Group Launch where we re-visited the purpose and goals of the ministry and committed the year to God. We thank God for the new relationships and Groups formed this year, the fellowship and accountability enjoyed by many, along with the

weekly/fortnightly/monthly opportunities to dive deeper into God's Word.

We pray for God to work in each Group member that they may grow in understanding, faith and godliness. We are looking forward to combined Group events such as the Praise & Prayer night and a training night with Christine Dillon (OMF) on personal evangelism.

Training & Discipleship | Cheuk Lam

There has been a growing emphasis on training and discipleship across all areas of the English congregation. Thank God for the servantheartedness of our congregation and for their willingness to be trained and equipped.

Training was provided in collaboration with the Welcoming and Follow-Up Ministry Lead to foster a more welcoming culture and to streamline the follow up of newcomers. One-on-one training was provided to a new service leader who is now rostered to serve on a regular basis. A guide was

compiled for in-service Bible readers to help them deliver God's word to the congregation faithfully and effectively.

Training was also provided to Growth Group leaders including a session on a Christian

overview and approach to mental health. There are more initiatives planned with a vision to have training and discipleship become central in all our ministries.

Women's Ministry | Jessica Cheung, Yin Ping Tang, Agatha Kim, Charissa Mak

Women's Ministry has sought to facilitate opportunities for relationship building among our sisters, especially across life stages.

This year, the Women's Ministry focused on 3 events to bring our sisters together.

In July, a group of ladies gathered at church for Equip22, a conference for women, which was streamed online with talks on Lamentations and interviews by women, which modelled how to have conversations about hard things women face, that pointed them to the hope we have in lesus

In November, we had a thanksgiving event where we heard from 3 sisters from different life

stages, who shared with vulnerability about their life joys and struggles and how they experienced God in the midst of these.

In February, we launched our 2x2 initiative, where women opted in to meet with a group of 4-5 women monthly to get to know one another over 6 months, to encourage one another over lunch or reading a book together.

We thank God for the community of women at English Ministry, who love and build another up intentionally. Please pray that we will continue to be intentional in journeying with each other in seeing each other grow in faith and maturity in Christ.

Men's Ministry | Marlon Chan

After a false start in 2021, Men's Ministry was relaunched with a BBQ lunch event last October. Pastor Jon gave a talk about the value of meeting up as Men to encourage and grow each other, while we had a couple of brothers share their testimonies.

The English service now has significant diversity across different age groups and life stages and the challenge is to take advantage of that diversity.

In February, we held a Men's lunch, where lunch was provided for men to meet in small groups, with men from different life stages. The event was well received, with feedback particularly from a few new brothers who appreciated the

opportunity to mix and get to know other men from other groups.

Later this year a few Men will be attending the Katoomba conference. Given that there is also the church wide camp and the busy church calendar, Men's Ministry will aim to organise one other event for later on this year.

We are thankful to God for his provisions for each of the events, for the mature hearts of men who attend intentionally with the purpose of encouraging fellow brothers, as well as the many new brothers who have joined our church in the last couple of years.

Mission & Partnering | Charissa Mak

This year, we were reminded and encouraged from the Qualities of Authentic Disciples sermon series, that as disciples of Jesus, we've been entrusted with the gospel and the task of sharing our faith with others, as well as partnering with missionaries who are involved in taking the gospel further away.

At a practical level, we facilitated our brothers and sisters to take part in missions, through praying for a missionary each Sunday during the corporate prayer, distributing monthly mission prayer letters, and growth groups adopting a missionary, and monthly mission spots at the Sunday Services.

This year, we heard from the following missionaries about their ministries: Hoi Yan Shea, Maicy Cacdac, Daniel and Kate Morris, Pete and Jo Ong, Mike and Joyce, Jeff and Belinda Callow, Charissa Mak, Will He, and Simon and Danielle Ball. It was great to hear from our own congregation members about their mission involvement in local and rural outreach to Bathurst and learning from National Training Event.

The workshops run by an OMF missionary challenged our understanding that mission is

not just done by our missionaries. In reality, an active sending church support team is needed for each missionary who is sent out, and we can all play a role on this team.

It's been encouraging to see how our church community is participating in missions, from Kids Church and Switch inviting missionaries to share, Growth Groups partnering with a missionary, to the kitchen ministry giving their surplus to the mission fund.

In previous years pre-COVID, we had at least one short term overseas mission each year which gave brothers and sisters first hand experience of cross-cultural missions. We've seen people come back changed, with a heart to serve in mission in some way. With international travel resuming, there will be a medical mission team going to the Philippines in September. Please pray that God will raise up leaders to lead mission teams in 2023-24, that more people can taste cross-cultural mission first hand, and be impacted by God's missional heart. May God continue to move our brothers and sisters, compelled by Christ's love and with the help of His Spirit, that we may share Jesus with those near and further away, for His glory.

Outreach & Evangelism

Investigating Christianity | Rev. Jon Phua

過去的一年裡,我們有幸以各種方式關懷我們的宣教士。從肆虐全球的疫情中走出來,意味着我們可以自由地親身與他們會面,並邀請他們來我們的主日崇拜中分享。在主日崇拜中,我們藉著每月更新和派發的代禱信為宣教士祈禱。每個成長小組也被指派一名宣教士來支持和親自關懷他們,這實在是一條雙向路,就是宣教士通過分享他們的事工從而得到鼓舞,同時也讓我們的會友得以聽到上帝在海外的作為。

在聖誕節期間,我們向我們支持的所有宣教士提供關懷的禮物選項,讓他們可從中選擇禮物。一些選項包括個人現金禮券、禮品咭或書籍。最受歡迎的選擇是亞馬遜禮品咭或 Woolworths / Coles 禮品咭,很多都對這種心意的表示致以感謝。

我們將繼續在靈福堂的弟兄姊妹的幫助下關懷我們的 宣教士。我們讚美上帝,因為我們有機會支持、鼓勵 和服侍祂所呼召的宣教士,讓他們在萬國中傳揚祂的 名,並宣揚耶穌的福音。

5. 差傳代禱信

目前每月的代禱信格式已經實施了兩年,除了敏感的地域,宣教工場和宣教士的照片不能公開外,一般都

會圖文並茂,深信這能幫助弟兄姊妹更了解宣教士的 近況和代禱需要,現時每一個宣教士或宣教機構都會 在一年內刊登三至四次,求神感動弟兄姊妹充分使用 代禱信,與前線的宣教士並肩作戰。

6. 從宣教儲備基金撥出一次性的奉獻

- a) \$4,000 支持杜偉雄牧師在澳洲中國信徒佈道會總幹 事工作
- b) \$4,500 支持Will He 在澳洲麥覺理大學事工

7. 2023 迪拜短宣

自2005 年以來,澳洲基督教播道會靈福堂一直在參與由華人福音普世差傳會(華傳 GOI)主導的迪拜短宣活動。隨着疫情之後各國的國境重新開放,今年我們將差派出第五支短宣隊,在年底前往迪拜進行短宣。來自國語堂的兩組家庭,以及英語堂的一名弟兄已經向GOI 遞交了他們的申請。從7月到12月,他們將在前往宣教工場之前接受培訓,裝備自己以便更好的和當地宣教士們同工。在宣教工場,他們將運用個人恩賜,在教導、帶領、兒童事工,姊妹和弟兄團契等不同的崗位進行服事。此次短宣為期兩週,從2023年12月25日到2024年1月8日。祈禱我們的上帝預備前往服事的弟兄姊妹們的心志和心思意念,以便在迪拜的宣教工場為主做出榮美的見證。

8. 菲律賓醫療和牙科短宣

2023年9月,澳洲播道會靈福堂的英語堂共有3位成員,將與其他7位主內弟兄姊妹組成一個醫療和牙科宣教團隊,為菲律賓的窮人服務。他們將用兩週時間看病,在馬尼拉周邊的兩個貧困地區傳播福音。Trece Martires (馬尼拉以南3小時車程)和Marilao (馬尼拉以北1小時車程)都是菲律賓無家可歸者的收容區,該團隊將為窮人和有需要的人提供服務,以滿足他們的健康和精神需求。他們將與當地基督徒合作,為居住在這些貧民區的當地菲律賓人提供免費的醫療和牙科護理、藥物、健康講座,並參與傳福音活動。

9. Orange 城鄉短宣

感謝上帝恩領我們實踐主耶穌基督向各城鄉的宣教工作,我們除了星期六在 Orange 派單張、號角和中

信、探訪、栽培、主辦福音晚會和兒童節目外,也會在主日參加 Orange St Barnabas Church 主日崇拜,藉此鼓勵當地華人弟兄姊妹參加英語崇拜(中文字幕+國語講道耳機錄播),祈求上帝恩領他們可以投入西人教會,打破語言障礙。

感謝上帝使李馮月芬傳道在3月帶領 Emma 姊妹決志信主,求上主幫助她明白真理。

回程時我們會到Bathurst 或Molong 或 Blayney 或 Lithgow 探訪餐館和派發中信、號角。

感謝上帝讓我們認識幾位從香港來的新朋友, 願上帝 引領她們早日認識基督, 信靠上帝。

感謝上帝在5月的短宣使用吳銘淇傳道和Katie師母帶領以利亞團10位團友體驗城鄉短宣 , 求上帝引領他們保持宣教的心,委身參與事奉。

我們很欣慰雖然不是海外宣教士,仍然可以出一分力,願上帝繼續幫助我們學習怎樣參與宣教。

2023-2024 Missions Budget remains \$155k. In the next financial year we decided to support Rev. Dennis To (Chinese Christian Mission Australia CEO), Will He (Macquarie University), Pilgrims Institute (Sri Lanka). Daniel & Kate Morris left France and therefore we stopped supporting them. May our Lord continue to bless them in Australia.

Here below are some highlights of the Mission Ministry during 2022-2023 :

1) Mission at English Congregation

As a congregation, we continue to encourage our brothers and sisters to take part in mission, through: praying for a missionary each Sunday during the corporate prayer and through monthly mission prayer letters, growth groups adopting a missionary, and monthly mission spots.

This year, we were encouraged by the following missionaries: Hoi Yan Shea, Maicy Cacdac, Daniel & Kate Morris, Peter & Joanne Ong, Mike & Joyce, Jeff & Belinda Callow, Charissa Mak, Will He, and Simon & Danielle Ball. It was also great to hear from our own congregation about their mission involvement in local and rural outreach to Orange.

It's been encouraging to see how our church community is participating in mission, including the kitchen ministry giving their surplus to the mission fund. May God continue to move our brothers and sisters, compelled by Christ's love and with the help of His Spirit, so we may share Jesus with those near and far, for His glory.

2) Mission at Cantonese and Mandarin Congregations

We had been arranged missionaries and mission organisations to share through Sunday Mission Spot, prayer meeting, Fellowships & Sunday School:

Hoi Yan Shea, Charissa Mak, Esther & Daniel, Peter & Joanne Ong, Rev. David Zheng, Jeff & Belinda Callow, Maicy Cacdac, and Will He.

We praise our Lord for answering our prayers and all the Fellowships in Cantonese Congregation has adopted a missionary or a missionary family. We hope that we are learning to care and support missionaries in this year.

3) Mission Workshop

The workshop run by an OMF missionary challenged our understanding that mission is

not just done by our missionaries. In reality, an active sending church support team is needed for each missionary who is sent out, and we can all play a role on this team.

4) Missionary Care

In the past year, we have had the privilege of caring for our missionaries in various ways. Coming out of the global pandemic means that we can freely catch up with them in person and invite them to share at our Sunday services. In the Sunday services, we pray for our missionaries with the help of the prayer letter that is updated and distributed every month. Growth Groups are also assigned a missionary to support and give personal care. This is a two-way street for the missionary to feel encouraged by sharing their ministry but also for our members to hear about God's work overseas.

During Christmas, we sent care packages to all missionaries we support, giving them gifts to choose from. Options include personal financial gift, gift cards and books. Popular options were Amazon gift cards and Woolworths / Coles gift cards. Many responded with thankfulness to the kind gesture.

We will continue to care for our missionaries with the help of our brothers and sisters at EFCA. We praise God for the opportunities through which we can support, encourage and serve the missionaries that He has called to go to make His name known among the nations and to proclaim the good news of Jesus.

5) Mission Prayer Newsletter

The new format of the monthly mission newsletter has been used for 2 years. Apart from the highly sensitive areas where the mission field and missionaries are intentionally not displayed, all come with pictures usually. We believe a picture tells a thousand words and it will help our congregation to more easily understand the updates and the prayer needs of the missionaries. At present each missionary or mission organisation will be featured three to

four times a year. Pray that brothers and sisters will fully utilise the newsletter to fight alongside the missionaries on the front lines.

6) One- off Donation from Mission Fund in 2022-2023

a) \$4000 to support Rev. Dennis To in Chinese Christian Mission Australia as CEO

b) \$4500 to support Will He's student ministry in Macquarie University

7) Dubai Missionary Trip 2023

EFCA Mission Committee has been participating in the UAE missionary program promoted by Gospel Operation International Australia (GOI) since 2015. With the opening of the borders after the pandemic, a fifth team will be sent out at the end of 2023. Five brothers and sisters, including two couples from Mandarin congregation and one from the English congregation have submitted their applications. They will be equipped by GOI from July to December before they go to the missionary field, getting prepared to partner with local missionaries in Dubai, using their spiritual gifts to serve in different roles, including teaching, leading, children's program, caring etc. The trip will last for two weeks from 25th Dec 2023 to 8th Jan 2024. Pray that our God will prepare the participants' hearts and minds for the expansion of His kingdom and glory his name in Dubai.

8) Philippines Medical and Dental Mission September 2023

In September 2023, 3 members from English congregation will be joining 7 other brothers and sisters in Christ to form a medical and dental mission team to serve the poor in the Philippines. For 2 weeks, they will spend time seeing patients, spreading the gospel in 2 poor areas around Manila. Trace Martires (3 hours south of Manila) and Marilao (1 hour north of

Manila) are both areas housing the homeless in Philippines and the team will be serving the poor and needy for their health and spiritual needs. They will team up with local Christians to provide free medical and dental care, medications, health talks and evangelistic activities for the local Filipinos living in these slum areas.

9) Orange Regional Short Term Mission

Praise the Lord for leading EFCA to follow Jesus' footstep to spread the gospel from town to town. We usually spend two days in these trips. On Saturday we will distribute flyers, Herald monthly newspaper, CCMA magazine, home & restaurant visitation, leading gospel events and children program. On Sunday we join the Sunday service at St Barnabas Church, hope that will encourage local Chinese brothers and sisters to join the English service too (Chinese subtitle on screen and Mandarin translation of sermons with earphone). We will visit Molong / Blayney/Bathurst / Lithgow after Sunday service too.

We praise the Lord that we witnessed Pastor Florence Lee leading one sister Emma accept Jesus as her Lord. Please pray for Emma that she will understand the truth and walking with Jesus for her whole life.


We praise the Lord that we met a few newcomers from Hong Kong. Pray that they will accept Jesus as their Saviour in future.


We were encouraged that while we may not all be overseas missionaries, we can still do our part.







1. Ministry income and other receipts

These are cash (in the form of offertory or gift) received for specific ministry activities (e.g. outreach, evangelism or camp etc) or church purpose (e.g. photocopying) and GST refunds.

Notes to Account

The accompanying notes form part of these financial statements.

1. Summary of Significant Accounting Policies

Financial Reporting Framework

The financial statements are special purpose financial statements prepared in order to satisfy the financial reporting requirements of the Australian Charities and Not-for-Profits Commission Act 2012 (ACNC Act). The committee has determined that the association is not a reporting entity as the users of the financial statements are able to obtain additional information to meet their needs.

The financial statements were authorized for issue on 13 August 2023 by the members of the committee.

Statement of Compliance

The financial report has been prepared in accordance with Australian Charities and Not-for-Profits Commission Act 2012 (ACNC Act)., and the basis of accounting specified by all Australian Accounting Standards and Interpretations.

Basis of Preparation

The financial statements have been prepared on an accrual basis and are based on historical costs. They do not take into account changing money values or, except where stated specifically, current valuations of non-current assets.

The following significant accounting policies, which are consistent with the previous period unless stated otherwise, have been adopted in the preparation of these financial statements.

(a) Income Tax

No provision for income tax has been raised as the entity is exempt from income tax under Div. 50 of the Income Tax Assessment Act 1997.

(b) Property, Plant and Equipment

Property

Properties comprising Land and Buildings which are stated at costs by the adoption of the cost model, as the association applied for such cost recognition under the AASB 116: Property Plant and Equipment, less accumulated depreciation (for Buildings) and subsequent accumulated impairment losses.

Plant and equipment

Leasehold improvements and office equipment are carried at cost less, where applicable, any accumulated depreciation. The depreciable amount of all PPE is depreciated on a straight-line basis over the useful lives of the assets to the association commencing from the time the asset is held ready for use. Leasehold improvements are amortised on a straight line basis over the shorter of either the unexpired period of the lease or the estimated useful lives of the improvements.

The depreciation rates used for each class of depreciable assets are:

(c) Impairment of Assets

At the end of each reporting period, the committee reviews the carrying amounts of its tangible and intangible assets to determine whether there is any indication that an asset may be impaired. If such an indication exists, the recoverable amount of the asset, being the higher of the asset's fair value less costs of disposal and value in use, is compared to the asset's carrying amount. Any excess of the asset's carrying amount over its recoverable amount is recognised in profit or loss.

(d) Employee Provisions

Provision is made for the association's liability for employee benefits arising from services rendered by employees to the end of the reporting period. Employee provisions have been measured at the amounts expected to be paid when the liability is settled.

(e) Provisions

Provisions are recognised when the association has a legal or constructive obligation, as a result of past events, for which it is probable that an outflow of economic benefits will result and that outflow can be reliably measured. Provisions are measured at the best estimate of the amounts required to settle the obligation at the end of the reporting period.

(f) Cash and Cash Equivalents

Cash and cash equivalents include cash on hand, deposits held at call with banks and other short-term highly liquid investments with original maturities of three months or less.

(g) Accounts Receivable and Other Debtors

Accounts receivable and other debtors include amounts due from GST claim and the new printing service provider. Receivables expected to be collected within 12 months of the end of the reporting period are classified as current assets.

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(h) Revenue and Other Income

Revenue is measured at the fair value of the consideration received or receivable. For this purpose, deferred consideration is not discounted to present values when recognising revenue.

Contributed assets

The association receives assets from the government and other parties for nil or nominal consideration in order to further its objectives. These assets are recognised in accordance with the recognition requirements of other applicable accounting standards (eg AASB 9, AASB 16, AASB 116 and AASB 138).

On initial recognition of an asset, the association recognises related amounts (being contributions by owners, lease liability, financial instruments, provisions, revenue or contract liability arising from a contract with a customer).

The association recognises income immediately in profit or loss as the difference between initial carrying amount of the asset and the related amount.

Operating Grants, Donations and Bequests

When the association receives operating grant revenue, donations or bequests, it assesses whether the contract is enforceable and has sufficiently specific performance obligations in accordance with AASB 15.

When both these conditions are satisfied, the association:

- identifies each performance obligation relating to the grant recognises a contract liability for its obligations under the agreement;
- recognises revenue as it satisfies its performance obligations.

Where the contract is not enforceable or does not have sufficiently specific performance obligations, the association:

- recognises the asset received in accordance with the recognition requirements of other applicable accounting standards (eg AASB 9, AASB 16, AASB 116 and AASB 138);
- recognises related amounts (being contributions by owners, lease liability, financial instruments, provisions, revenue or contract liability arising from a contract with a customer); and
- recognises income immediately in profit or loss as the difference between the initial carrying amount of the asset and the related amount.

If a contract liability is recognised as a related amount above, the Association recognises income in profit or loss when or as it satisfies its obligations under the contract.

Capital Grant

When the association receives a capital grant, it recognises a liability for the excess of the initial carrying amount of the financial asset received over any related amounts (being contributions by owners, lease liability, financial instruments, provisions, revenue or contract liability arising from a contract with a customer) recognised under other Australian Accounting Standards.

The association recognises income in profit or loss when or as the association satisfies its obligations under the terms of the grant.

Interest Income

Interest income is recognised using the effective interest method.

(i) Leases

At inception of a contract, the association assesses if the contract contains or is a lease. If there is a lease present, a right-of-use asset and a corresponding lease liability is recognised by the association where the association is a lessee. However, all contracts that are classified as short-term leases (lease with remaining lease term of 12 months or less) and leases of low value assets are recognised as an operating expense on a straight-line basis over the term of the lease.

Concessionary Leases

For leases that have significantly below-market terms and conditions principally to enable the association to further its objectives (commonly known as peppercorn/concessionary leases), the association has adopted the temporary relief under AASB 2018-8 and measures the right of use assets at cost on initial recognition.

(j) Goods and Services Tax (GST)

Revenues, expenses and assets are recognised net of the amount of GST, except where the amount of GST incurred is not recoverable from the Australian Taxation Office (ATO). Receivables and payables are stated inclusive of the amount of GST receivable or payable. The net amount of GST recoverable from, or payable to, the ATO is included with other receivables or payables in the assets and liabilities statement.

(k) New and Amended Accounting Policies Adopted by the Association

Initial adoption of AASB 2021-3: COVID-19 - Related Rent Concessions beyond 30 June 2021

AASB 2021-3 Amendments to Australian Accounting Standards – Covid-19 - Related Rent Concessions beyond 30 June 2021 amends AASB 16: Leases by providing a twelve month extension to the practical expedient that permits lessees to assess whether rent concessions that occur as a direct consequence of the COVID-19 pandemic and, if certain conditions are met, account for those rent concessions as if they were not lease modifications.

As at the assets and liabilities statement date, the association has recorded a Provision – Sundry which is consisted of \$30,054 (2022: \$59,719) being amounts provided for future expenditure for which services or goods have not yet been received by the end of the financial year and accordingly should not have been recognised as provisions in accordance with the recognition criteria of the accounting policy that provisions are recognised when the association has a legal or constructive obligation, as a result of past events. The balance of \$30,054 (2022: \$59,719) is comprised of anticipated legal fee for the new pastors' visas application and processing assistance \$19,008 (2022: 40,000), professional development allowance of all pastors \$ nil (2022: 3,719), and the provisions for aged care and the air conditioning major repairs \$11,046 (2022: \$16,000).

8. Events After the Reporting Period

Other than the following, the committee is not aware of any significant events since the end of the reporting period.

The war in Ukraine and related events take place at a time of significant global economic uncertainty and volatility, and the effects are likely to interact with and exacerbate the effects of current market conditions. Many sectors/jurisdictions are already facing the impacts of rising commodity prices and increased raw materials costs, as a result of surging consumer demand as the COVID-19 pandemic eases. Supply-chain bottlenecks, arising from the effects of the pandemic, continue to persist, and are heightened by labour shortages and trade friction. These conditions may be significantly exacerbated by the wider effects of the war in Ukraine, increasing inflationary pressures and weakening the global post-pandemic recovery.

At the time of reporting, it is difficult to estimate the financial effects and impacts attributable to the church's operations or offertories which sustain the operations. Accordingly, the amounts recognised in the financial statements have not been adjusted to reflect such events, which have resulted in increase / decrease in value of the fund's investment assets on the date of issuing the audit report.

Opinion

We have audited the financial report of Evangelical Free Church of Australia (the association), which comprises the assets and liabilities statement as at 30 June 2023, the income and expenditure statement for the year then ended, and notes to the financial statements, including a summary of significant accounting policies, and the certification by members of the committee.

In our opinion, the accompanying financial report of the association has been prepared in accordance with Division 60 of the Australian Charities and Not-for-Profits Commission Act 2012 (ACNC Act), including:

- i. giving a true and fair view of the association's financial position as at 30 June 2023 and of its financial performance for the year then ended; and
- ii. complying with Australian Accounting Standards to the extent described in Note 1, and Division 60 the Australian Charities and Not-for-profits Commission Regulation 2013.

Basis for Opinion

We conducted our audit in accordance with Australian Auditing Standards. Our responsibilities under those standards are further described in the *Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Report* section of our report. We are independent of the association in accordance with the ethical requirements of the Accounting Professional and Ethical Standards Board's APES 110: *Code of Ethics for Professional Accountants (including Independence Standards)* (the Code) that are relevant to our audit of the financial report in Australia. We have also fulfilled our other ethical responsibilities in accordance with the Code. We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our opinion.

Emphasis of Matter - Basis of Accounting

We draw attention to Note 1 to the financial report, which describes the basis of accounting. The financial report has been prepared to assist the association to meet the requirements of the ACNC Act. As a result, the financial report may not be suitable for another purpose. Our opinion is not modified in respect of this matter.

Emphasis of Matters - Provisions Overstated

We draw attention to Note 7 to the financial report, which describes the provisions in the accounts and its departure in accounting treatment from the association's principal accounting policy as recorded in Note 1(e) to the financial report. As the financial report has to comply with all recognition and measurement requirements in Australian Accounting Standards, such departure of amounts overstated by \$30,054 (2022 : \$59,719) have effects as described in Note 7 on the association's financial position as at 30 June 2023 and of its financial performance for the year then ended.

Key Audit Matter - Properties Carrying Values and Impairment Charges

Without qualification to the opinion expressed above, we draw attention to Note 4 to the financial report, which describes the properties comprising land and buildings of \$809,037 (2022: \$822,874) as compared to total assets of \$4,580,551 (2022: \$4,445,864) as at 30 June 2023 and 2022, respectively. In accordance with AASB 2016-4: Amendments to Australian Accounting Standards – Recoverable Amount of Non Cash-Generating Specialised Assets of Not-for-Profit Entities, which clarify that the recoverable amount of primarily non-cash-generating assets of not-for-profit entities, which are typically specialised in nature and held for continuing use of their service capacity, is expected to be materially the same as fair value determined under AASB 13 Fair Value Measurement, with the consequence that:

- (i) AASB 136 does not apply to such assets that are regularly revalued to fair value under the revaluation model in AASB 116 Property, Plant and Equipment and AASB 138 Intangible Assets; and
- (ii) AASB 136 applies to such assets accounted for under the cost model in AASB 116 and AASB 138.

In accordance with AASB 136: Impairment of Assets for Not-For-Profit (NFP) entities only, the association shall assess at the end of each reporting period whether there is any indication that an asset may be impaired. If any such indication exists, the association shall estimate the recoverable amount of the asset. We have enquired and confirmed with the Committee that there is no indication of asset impairment as the properties remain to be occupied, maintained and used for church activities which we observed during our audit site visits.

Responsibilities of the Committee for the Financial Report

The Committee of the association are responsible for the preparation of the financial report that gives a true and fair view and have determined that the basis of preparation described in Note 1 to the financial report is appropriate to meet the requirements of the ACNC Act and the needs of the members. The committee's responsibility also includes such internal control as the committee determine is necessary to enable the preparation of the financial report that gives a true and fair view and is free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

In preparing the financial report, the committee is responsible for assessing the association's ability to continue as a going concern, disclosing, as applicable, matters relating to going concern and using the going concern basis of accounting unless the committee either intends to liquidate the association or to cease operations, or has no realistic alternative but to do so.
